COLFAX, WA- Deputies arrest 9 time convicted felon breaking into vehicles at local business south of Colfax.

Shortly after 1am on Wednesday morning, deputies were called to Huber Action Freight, just south of Colfax, after reports of an individual at that location trying to wave down passing motorists.

When Deputy Randy Miller arrived on scene he confronted a subject, identified as 31yoa Jarrett Lynn Reedy of Spokane WA, in the parking lot of the business. According to Miller, Reedy told him he was trying to contact someone at the office. As Deputy Miller spoke with Reedy he noticed the handle of a firearm sticking out of the pocket of his sweatshirt. Miller ordered Reedy to the ground and safely secured the scene until backup units could arrive.

It was later determined that Jarrett, a 9 time convicted felon had stolen the firearm out of an employee's vehicle.

After additional investigation deputies determined that Reedy had also broken into a vehicle at another business just down the road. That incident is still under investigation.

Reedy was later booked into the Whitman County Sheriff's Office on charges of Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, Vehicle Prowl 2nd Degree, Theft of a Firearm, and Criminal Trespassing in the 2nd Degree.
