

Environmental Health

Food Protection

- ✓ 75+ Food Service Establishment Inspections
- ✓ 30 Temporary Event Permits (15 separate local events)
 - proper handwashing
 - glove use,
 - temperature control,
 - and proper cooking temperatures.
- ✓ 7 new facilities are permitted or completing the process
- ✓ 2 Schools (Pullman High School and Colton) have been approved
- ✓ All staff are now ServSafe Certified
- ✓ Food and Drug Administration's Office of Regulatory Affairs training and FDA Standardization
- ✓ Regional Food Safety Program meeting
- ✓ Due to inspections scores or practices resulting in the potential for public health concern, two facilities are now required to have a meeting with the Whitman County Health Officer, Dr. Brad Bowman.
- ✓ New applications to conduct establishments, educational handouts, and new database to track records.



Environmental Health

Onsite Sewage Program

- ✓ 15+ Completed (near completed) OSS projects
- ✓ 6 OSS failures found and corrected/currently working to be resolved
- ✓ 7 OSS permits
- ✓ GIS database to record onsite information
- ✓ Updated OSS database to coincide with all paper and historical permits
- ✓ Additional soils training in NE Tri Counties (Pend Oreille, Stevens, and Ferry Counties).
- ✓ WOSSA (Washington On-Site Sewage Association) Certifications
- ✓ Building Department -19 total permits. EH required to review and sign off on 10.
- ✓ Planning Department- 21 total RHCs. 12 completed. EH required to review and sign off on all 12.

Drinking Water




- ✓ Met with Department of Health at Regional Headquarters to discuss local vs. State roles in drinking water protection.

 - Identified public health concerns at each facility.
 - Compliance schedules developed
 - 2 pools to be completely redesigned
- ✓ New designs for apartments and Pullman City Pool have been approved.
- ✓ Follow up visit on fatality at Colfax pool (unrelated to pool or pool conditions)




Environmental Health

- ✓ Partnership with Whitman County Department of Emergency Communications for Incident Command trailer and mobile satellite communications dish.
- ✓ Environmental staff completed ICS 26, ICS 100, and ICS 700. Community Points of Distribution (CPODs) training with Washington State University and Whitman County Emergency Management.
- ✓ Updates to 5-year plan and ConCon deliverables
