***Whitman County Canvassing Board meeting regarding a mandatory
recount of ballots for the Town of Uniontown City Council No. 4
Position***

Colfax, WA – The Whitman County Canvassing Board will meet to discuss the mandatory recount for the Town of Uniontown City Council No. 4 race due to a tie between the two candidates: Jack Espy and Jonathan Musson. A date will be set at this meeting for the mandatory recount and certification of the results, as well as a subsequent lot draw (if the certified recount result ends in a tie).

The public is invited to attend the Canvassing Board meeting, which will be held at the Whitman County Elections Department (304 N. Main St., Colfax, WA) on Monday, December 2 at 8:30 am.

A mandatory recount is required when the certified count results in a difference between two candidates of less than 150 votes and less than one quarter of one percent.
